Rule Summary

The Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) has a vital interest in maintaining a healthy and safe environment for its students, participants, employees, and visitors.

Rule

1. REQUIREMENTS

All forms of smoking and tobacco products including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipes, smokeless tobacco, snuff and chewing tobacco, and electronic cigarettes (includes vapors, personal vaporizers, tanks and other electronic nicotine delivery system) are prohibited in all TEEX facilities. Facilities means all grounds, buildings and structures, sidewalks and walkways, parking structures, and all vehicles owned, leased, or otherwise controlled by TEEX.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES

- 2.1. This rule relies on the thoughtfulness, consideration and cooperation of tobacco users and non-tobacco users for its success. It is the responsibility of all TEEX employees, students, participants, and visitors to observe these requirements. Those violating the rule should be reminded of this rule and asked to comply.
- 2.2. Division directors will be responsible for communicating this rule to everyone who occupies facilities or uses vehicles owned or leased by TEEX.
- 2.3. It is the responsibility of the person in charge of delivering training to inform participants of the requirements of this rule while participating in training at facilities owned, leased or provided to TEEX.
