



Documentation for Pro Board Certification Requirements (472 HAZMAT ONLY)

- ✓ Certification requirements (prerequisite) must be submitted on or before the last day of class. If submitted after the last day of class, a \$75 fee will be charged. Prerequisites must be completed and dated prior to class end date.
- ✓ Certificates of completion from entities other than TEEX can be provided for all **HazMat** levels but must state the following:
 - Candidate's name
 - Training institution
 - Name of training (e.g. Hazardous Materials Technician is acceptable. Hazardous Materials training is not)
 - Training was in accordance with NFPA 472
 - Issuing date
- ✓ **For 472 Awareness and Operations ONLY**, a transcript from the company training department, Human Resources, or safety division can also be accepted and must include the following information:
 - Candidate's name
 - Issuing company
 - Name of training (e.g. Hazardous Materials Technician is acceptable. Hazardous Materials training is not)
 - Issuing date
 - Training was in accordance with NFPA 472
- ✓ For 472 **TEEX** Certificates of Completion, all TEEX HazMat training is in compliance with NFPA 472. Certificates must include:
 - Candidate's name
 - Name of training (e.g. Hazardous Materials Technician is acceptable. Hazardous Materials training is not)
 - Issuing date
- ✓ If HazMat documentation **ONLY** states **OSHA 1910.120** or does not state what the training is in accordance with, **a course syllabus must be provided**. The certification and syllabus will be reviewed by an SME from the ESTI Certification Office and compared to NFPA 472 to determine if the training meets the requirements of NFPA.

Documentation for Pro Board Certification Requirements (GENERAL)

- ✓ A Pro Board or IFSAC certificate
- ✓ Printout from Pro Board, DoD, TCFP or similar lookup system
- ✓ Recognized State Agency, State Fire Marshals Office, State Training, or Certificate Board within the state. The certificate or transcript must include the following:
 - State issuing the certification (name, seal, stamp or logo)
 - Candidate's name
 - Issuance date
 - Length of course, if listed, should be in accordance with the typical length for that discipline.
