PAYMENT FOR TUITION:

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

All Students attending a U.S. Coast Guard approved course are now required to provide TEEX with a picture ID on the first day of class.

- In order to participate in interior firefighting projects, participants' facial hair must meet OSHA requirements for wearing Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA). Beards or long sideburns are not allowed. The student must be clean shaven except for mustaches, prior to attending class.
- Clothing will be normal, everyday outdoor work attire.
- Full-length pants are required for all participants; shorts are strictly prohibited for any type of training outside the classroom.
- Short sleeve shirts are allowed, but sleeveless shirts are prohibited.
- Close-toed shoes must be worn at all times, regardless of classroom or exterior training exercises.
