

GENERAL REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Marine Firefighting Advanced Marine Firefighting, Advanced Marine Firefighting Refresher and Combined Marine Firefighting Courses

- LOCATION:** Classroom sessions are conducted at the:

- CLASS TIMES:** Basic Marine Firefighting & Combined Marine Firefighting will begin at 8:00 AM on Monday morning. Basic ends at 5:00 PM on Tuesday and Combined ends at noon on Friday.
- Advanced Marine Firefighting will begin at 8:00 AM on Tuesday morning and ends at noon on Friday.
 - Advanced Marine Firefighting **Refresher** begins at 8:00 AM on Wednesday morning and ends at noon on Thursday.
- PAYMENT FOR TUITION:** Tuition is required prior to class start date. We accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, cash, check, and Purchase Order.
- IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:** All Students attending a U.S. Coast Guard approved course are now required to provide TEEX with a picture ID on the first day of class.
Driver’s License, MMD, Passport, Armed Forces ID, etc.
- DRESS:**
- In order to participate in interior firefighting projects, participants’ facial hair must meet OSHA requirements for wearing Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA). Beards or long sideburns are not allowed. The student must be clean shaven except for mustaches, prior to attending class.
 - Clothing will be normal, everyday outdoor work attire.
 - Full-length pants are required for all participants; shorts are strictly prohibited for any type of training outside the classroom.
 - Short sleeve shirts are allowed, but sleeveless shirts are prohibited.
 - Close-toed shoes must be worn at all times, regardless of classroom or exterior training exercises.
- RISK RELEASE:** Students will be required to sign a risk release form at the start of class. If you wish to review the risk release prior to the start of class; please visit our web site at www.teex.org/marine .
- MEALS:** Noon meals are included in the fee for all 8 hour training days. The fee does not include breakfast, dinner or lodging. All other meals may be purchased at local restaurants.
