# **Transfer and Cancellation Policy**

If you cannot attend a class, you MUST contact the program representative of the course you registered for in advance to either transfer or cancel your registration, all request must be made in writing. Please refer to the Transfer, Cancellation, Refund and No-Show Policies below.

Transfers:

Transfers to another scheduled class (or from one customer to another) are accepted at any time before the start of the class at no charge. Customers are encouraged to transfer to a future scheduled class of the same course. All request for transfers must be made in writing.

- If the customer cannot transfer to a scheduled class of the same course, then he/she may transfer to another class of a different course and receive either a refund or pay the difference between the two class fees (if applicable). Request for transfer/refund must be made in writing.
- If the customer cannot attend any scheduled class, then the Cancellation/Refund Policy is in effect. A written request for refund must be received before cancellation/refund is processed.

# Cancellations/Refunds:

- With the exception of the TEEX Fire Recruit Academy (face-to-face classes), TEEX will provide a full refund if you cancel 15 or more calendar days before the start of the class, request must be made in writing. The TEEX Fire Recruit Academy (face-to-face classes) will retain the publicized cancellation fee regardless of when you cancel.

# **Prerequisites**

### ALL VERIFICATIONS MUST BE FORWARDED PRIOR TO THE START OF THE CLASS.

**NFPA 1081 Industrial Interior & Exterior Fire Brigade Certification Requirement:** If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must provide documentation that you have received training to NFPA 472 HazMat Awareness or higher. The documentation must be dated on or before the last day of this course and meet the requirements of the certification office.

NFPA 472 Chapter 16 Flammable Liquid Bulk Storage Specialist Certification Requirement: If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must provide documentation that you have received training to NFPA472 HazMat Technician. The documentation must be dated on or before the last day of this course and meet the requirements of the certification office.

**NFPA 1041 Instructor I** Certification Requirement: If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must present photo I.D. before taking written exam. To receive Pro Board certification, student must successfully complete the required practical assessment and written exam. Students must bring computer to use during class.

**NFPA 1041 Instructor II:** If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must provide documentation that you are certified (state or nationally) to NFPA 1041 Instructor 1. The documentation must be dated on or before the last day of this course and meet the requirements of the certification office. Students must bring computer to use during class.

**NFPA 1081 Fire Brigade Leadership Certification Requirements**: If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must provide documentation that you are certified (state or nationally) to NFPA 1081 Exterior or Interior Fire Brigade Member. The documentation must be dated on or before the last day of this course and meet the requirements of the certification office.

NFPA 1006 Confined Space Level I & II Certification Requirements: If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must pass the NFPA 1006 Chapter 5, "Job Performance Requirements" portion of the written exam and skills to receive Level I and II certification. Candidates must pass Level I to qualify for certification to Level II. Written and skills testing for Confined Space Rescue Level I and II will be conducted on day 4 and 5.

**NFPA 1006 Rope Rescue Level I Certification Requirements:** If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must pass the NFPA 1006 Chapter 5, "Job Performance Requirements" portion of the written exam and skills to receive Rope Rescue Level I certification.

NFPA 1006 Rope Rescue Level II Certification Requirements: If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must provide documentation that you are certified (IFSAC or Pro Board) to NFPA 1006 Rope Rescue Level I. The documentation must be dated on or before the last day of this course and meet the requirements of the certification office.

NFPA 1006 Trench Rescue Levels I & II Certification Requirements: If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must provide documentation that you are certified (Pro Board or IFSAC) to NFPA 1006 Rope Rescue Level I or NFPA 1006 Confined Space Rescue Level I or higher. The documentation must be dated on or before the last day of this course and meet the requirements of the certification office. Candidates must pass the written and skills exam for Trench Level I to qualify for certification to Trench Level II

**NFPA 1072 Hazardous Materials Technician Training Certification Requirements:** If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must provide documentation that you have received training to NFPA 472 Chapter 5, HazMat Core Operations or higher. The documentation must be dated on or before the last day of this course and meet the requirements of the certification office.

NFPA 472 Hazardous Materials Transport Specialist Training Certification Requirements: If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must provide documentation that you have received training to NFPA472 HazMat Technician. The documentation must be dated on or before the last day of this course and meet the requirements of the certification office.

NFPA 1072 Hazardous Materials Incident Commander Certification Requirements: If you are pursuing Pro Board certification, you must provide documentation that you have received training to NFPA 472 Chapter 5, HazMat Core Operations or higher. The documentation must be dated on or before the last day of this course and meet the requirements of the certification office.
