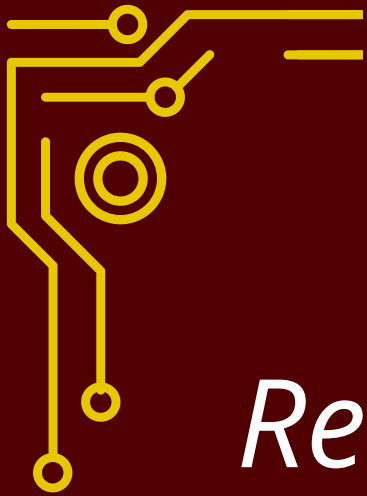

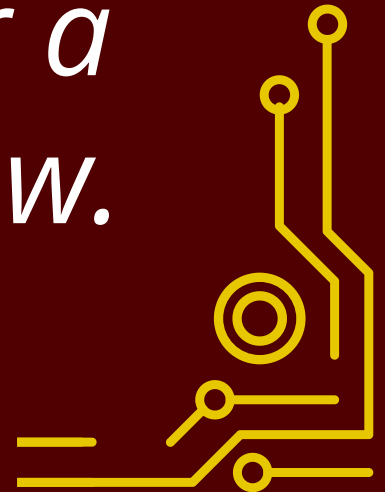

- Professional headshot (high-resolution)
- Biography (100–200 words, third person)
- Session title and description (100–300 words)
- Learning objectives
- Target audience
- Preferred session length
- Availability
