Rule Summary

The Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) must dispose of abandoned and unclaimed property as provided in this rule.

Definitions

Abandoned or Unclaimed Property

Rule

- 1. For abandoned and unclaimed personal property in TEEX possession the following apply:
 - 1.1. Release to Owner: Upon receiving proper identification and proof of ownership all abandoned and unclaimed property must be released to the owner, except when the property is being held as evidence in a pending criminal case.
 - 1.1.1. All property abandoned and/or otherwise determined to be evidence in a reported crime must be released to law enforcement personnel with jurisdictional responsibility as required by law.
 - 1.2. Attempt to Notify: If the owner is known, notify them via mail of the abandoned or unclaimed personal property within a reasonable amount of time. If the owner is unknown, publish a public notice to attempt to find the owners of abandoned and unclaimed personal property.
 - 1.3. Surplus: After 90 days of holding the abandoned and unclaimed property, follow the <u>TEEX Standard Administrative Procedure (SAP) 21.01.09.N0.01, Property Acquisition,</u> <u>Responsibility, and Accountability</u>.
