The Call for Presenters form is an online application. You will need to have the following checklist items ready to submit with your application. To be considered as a speaker, your proposal **MUST** include:

- Presenter name, title, employer, address, email and cell phone number
- Co presenter name(s)
- Current professional photo of yourself and any co-presenter(s)  
*(minimum size: 4"x6" at 300 dpi. File formats we accept: jpeg, png or tiff)*
- Brief biography written in third person that highlights your career or educational experience. *(100 - 200 words)*
- Session Title
- Learning Objectives
- Session Description *(100-300 words)*
- Target Audience
- Session Length: 1-hour session or 2-hour session
- Time/Date Availability
- You will also need to answer the following questions:
  - Why would this topic be of interest for the attendees?
  - How do you intend to accomplish the learning outcomes that attendees will take away from the presentation?
  - Please describe any materials or handouts you will share with your attendees.
  - Has the proposed presentation or content been presented at other events? If so, please provide a brief list of the events.
  - Are you willing to serve on a speaking panel?  
*(topics of discussion will be sent prior to the panel)*
