

TCFP Pro Board Certification Acceptance

At the January 2014 meeting of the Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP) Board of Commissioners, a big decision was made that affects firefighters across the state. The Commissioners unanimously voted to approve a reciprocity policy that allows some Pro Board certifications given by TEEEX to be submitted through the state system to receive TCFP certification.

What certifications are eligible for reciprocity?

The policy language approved by the Commissioners includes several conditions for Pro Board certification to be accepted by TCFP for state certification. TCFP will accept Pro Board certifications from TEEEX, without additional state testing, under the following conditions:

- the Pro Board certifications must be issued by TEEEX,
- the Pro Board certifications must be issued for certain National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards, levels, and edition years (see chart below),
- the Pro Board exam must be administered in English only, and
- the Pro Board certification must be issued for a course that was approved by TCFP prior to the delivery of the course.


Your badge will be scanned twice daily. It will be your responsibility to make sure you are scanned by a staff member at class and/or on a project.

- Make a course of 70 or above on examination.


