PWRT teams were actively engaged in response operations across Houston, Lake Jackson, Surfside Beach, and San Antonio. Members provided critical support with generator issues, water system challenges, and logistics coordination. The State Operations Center (SOC) remained fully staffed, and a PWRT Liaison supported operations at the FEMA generator site in Angleton.

In partnership with TDEM, PWRT members moved truckloads of commodities to and from NRG Stadium. The water/wastewater Strike Team assisted the City of Surfside Beach with wastewater system restoration, utilities support, and critical infrastructure damage assessments throughout the island community.

During the response, ESF-3 SOC Liaison Hannah Robinson had the opportunity to brief Acting Governor Patrick on PWRT's mission and daily operations, highlighting the team's vital role in supporting Texas communities during disasters.

This deployment lasted a total of 27 days, with PWRT members providing sustained support to multiple communities. Through these efforts, PWRT continues to strengthen community resilience, restore critical services, and accelerate recovery for Texans impacted by major disasters.
