

## General Reporting Instructions Oil Spill Control Courses

**Location:** Classroom sessions are conducted at the Center for Marine Training and Safety, Emergency Services Training Institute, Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service, Texas A&M University, located at **8609 Teichman Road, Galveston, Texas 77554.**

**Class Times:** **40 Hour – Oil Spill; Tactical and Operations**

- Monday-Thursday: 8:00am-5:00pm
- Friday: 8:00am-12pm

**Dress:** Classroom sessions: Appropriate Street or work clothes, closed-toe shoes.

**Practical/Field sessions:**

**The school will provide the following items:** ANSI Z89 approved hard-hats, cloth working gloves, life jackets and disposable ear protection. Students, however, may choose to bring their own personal work gloves for the practical exercises.

**Students should bring the following: Dress for weather conditions; if inclement weather is a possibility, bring your own foul weather gear.** Normal, everyday outdoor work attire and full-length pants are required for all participants; shorts are strictly prohibited for any type of training outside the classroom. Short sleeves are allowed, but sleeveless shirts are prohibited. Closed-toe shoes must be worn at all times, regardless of classroom or exterior training exercises. Closed-toe shoes worn during field exercises must be Z41/ASTM approved safety toe boots. ANI Z87 approved protective eyewear must be worn during all hands-on training exercises. Additionally, please be aware that this is considered a “working” class. Pending foul weather, students should be expected to be outside the majority of the day. If desired, students may want to bring gear that can get dirty, such as coveralls and a messier pair of boots.

**Meals:** Meals may be purchased at local restaurants. Students will need to provide transportation to and from the facility.
