Choose course, register, and pay online:

- **Registration will be open until July 12, 2026 at Noon. No walk-ins will be accepted after the deadline.**
- Students are required to complete their own registration. The trainer portal was discontinued on September 1, 2025.
- Pay online with credit card, eCheck, or department purchase order (PO).
- Payments must be made with U.S. currency or checks drawn on U.S. banks.
- Online registrations will be processed as they occur.

Cancellations/Transfers

Cancellations must be in writing. You may easily cancel your registration by using the blue envelope icon on your student portal. Cancellations within 14 days of class and No Shows are responsible for 10% of tuition.

Reminder: TEEX has implemented a \$50 administrative fee for customers requiring special handling on registration changes such as class transfers. *This fee is non-refundable and not reimbursable by Texas A&M Forest Service.*

Fire Department Assistance from Texas A&M Forest Service

What is Available?

Texas A&M Forest Service provides training tuition grants for both volunteer and career departments.

Reimbursement Rate

Training tuition grants are available up to a maximum of \$140/day, not to exceed **\$700 per trainee**. Tuition grants only cover the cost of tuition, and do not cover any cancellation/transfer fees.

Please Note

Submitting a training tuition grant request through TFS does not register you for Municipal School. You must complete the TEEX registration process to register for classes.

Grant Application Procedure

Training tuition grant assistance is requested and processed on FireConnect (<http://fireconnect.tfs.tamu.edu>).

At least 1 day prior to the first day of class, submit a training tuition request for each class being taken at Municipal School. **Be sure to select "TEEX Municipal School" as the Provider.**

Editing request details requires re-approval and therefore must also be completed at least 1 day prior to course start date.

If your request is approved, you then attend the training course(s). Following that, return to your tuition request(s) on FireConnect. Click "I Want To" and select "Submit for Reimbursement." The prompt will then ask you for information and to upload documentation.

Once you've submitted for reimbursement, TFS grants staff will process your request. If any information is missing or needed, you will be contacted to update the request.

Once all documentation is accounted for, the request(s) will be marked as Approved for Payment and reimbursement will be issued to your department.

Important Notice

Visit **FireConnect** to ensure that your department profile information is up to date. On your profile, click 'Edit Profile' and update information on all tabs. It is crucial to keep this information current, as it affects grant eligibility.
