PRO BOARD CERTIFICATION

Documentation of the certification requirements will be collected before or during the course and submitted to the ESTI Certification Office. If the certification requirement is not submitted during the courses, the participant will incur an automatic late fee of \$75 and will have six months to submit the approved documentation. Certification requirement documentation must be dated on or before the class end date.

Participants will not be able to appeal the late fee or six month deadline. Students must present a photo ID to the proctor before testing.
