

Acceptable Documentation for Pro Board Certification Prerequisites

- ✓ A Pro Board or International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) certificate, or
- ✓ A printout from Pro Board, Department of Defense (DoD), Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP) or similar lookup system, or
- ✓ A certificate from the designated state training entity (examples: Mississippi Certified Firefighter or Firefighter II, Maine State Training)

All certificates must include the following:

- Name of entity issuing certification
- Seal, stamp, or logo (if applicable)
- National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standard and level (e.g., NFPA 1081 Advanced Exterior Facility Fire Brigade Member)
- Candidate's name
- Certification number (if applicable)
- Issuance date

Note: If the certificate does not include the standard information, the issuing entity can provide written documentation verifying the appropriate standard.

Acceptable Documentation for NFPA 470 Hazardous Materials Prerequisites

- ✓ A Pro Board, IFSAC, or State certification referencing NFPA 470, NFPA 1072, or NFPA 472 standard and level, or
- ✓ A certificate of completion from the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) (e.g., in-house or third-party) including all of the items listed above, and stating the participant has completed training that meets the objectives of:
 - o NFPA 472 (2013 edition or prior), or
 - NFPA 1072 (2017 edition), or
 - NFPA 470 (2023 edition).

Exceptions:

- All NFPA 470, 1072, and 472 editions may be used as a prerequisite for Transportation Specialist classes.
- Certificates for NFPA 472 Operations (2002 edition and prior) include the
 mission-specific competencies (e.g., Personal Protective Equipment [PPE]).
 Candidates presenting prerequisite documentation for NFPA 472 Operations
 (2008 edition or later) must also submit separate documentation of the missionspecific competencies.
