To perform interior fire operations safely and effectively, a firefighter must master all aspects of an SCBA from daily maintenance and checks to emergency operations. Anything less puts firefighters at unnecessary risk. This course starts from the very beginning providing students a foundation of understanding on the basics of SCBA use and methodology. As the class unfolds, students build on that foundation, learning advanced SCBA techniques including VEIS, Search and Rescue, Emergency Breathing Techniques, etc. All TCFP/SFFMA, FFI and FFII objectives are met.	4
